Most decisions we make affect those around us and the decision to have an abortion is no different. Abortion is not only a loss to the parents, but also a lost blessing to those that would have been touched by the life of that child. The WRMC strives to stop the harm and heartache that result from abortion by assisting couples in exploring alternative options. Lay counseling along with available resources, give the opportunity to offer hope for the future, healing from the past and meet the needs of the present.

Impact of WRMCSN

In 2005 alone, the WRMCSN served 5,315 women, saw 120 salvations, and saved 168 babies.

From 1985 - 2005 ...

- ◆ over 43,000 clients had an opportunity to hear the Gospel.
- ◆ over 100,000 clients had been served.
- ◆ approximately 2000 babies were saved.
- ◆ two centers with hundreds of volunteers.
- ◆ as one of America's busiest crisis pregnancy centers, we see 8 times the national average of new clients per year and serve more clients per month than most other centers serve annually.

How *LIFERS* can get involved:

1. get involved by giving.
2. get involved by volunteering.



Giving: You can get involved with the WRMCSN through one of three areas of giving: a) giving financially through the **simple giving plan** or through one of the three Baby Bottle Campaigns (**Sanctity of human life week:** Jan. 20-27; **Mother's Day:** May 11; and **Father's Day:** June 15); b) giving of time as a volunteer; c) giving materially (some of those needs include: gently used maternity clothes; gently used baby clothes up to size 4T; gently used baby furniture; baby sundry items; diapers and Formula; new baby bottles, rattles, pacifiers and new baby stuffed animals).

Volunteering: The ministry of the WRMCSN is so multi-faceted that virtually any type of help and/or involvement is needed: from event volunteers to helping in the development department, from preparing for events to follow-up, from spending time with children to counseling, from giving of time to giving materially, there is a place for you.

The best place to start is attending one of the WRMCSN's Volunteer Training sessions, which not only give a broad overview over the history, ministry, and success stories of the WRMCSN, but also allow the attendee to find a place of service that best suits him/her.

The training sessions for 2008 are as follows: **January** 22, 24, 26, 31; **May** 6, 8, 10, 13, 15, **October** 7, 9, 11, 14, 16. Male Advisors and female Peer Counselors are always needed!
